

**FIELD TRIP
RULES AND GUIDELINES**

1. All students are expected to abide by all AIS rules and guidelines as listed in the handbook, including the prohibition of the use of tobacco products, alcohol, and drugs.
2. All students are to abide by the rules established by the organization hired by the school to provide the field trip experience.
3. Students are to be respectful at all times to AIS staff and other adults designated to work with them and fellow students.
4. Students are expected to arrive to activities promptly and to participate to the fullest of their abilities.
5. Students will have a specific chaperone responsible for them and will be required at designated times to check in with them.
6. Students are allowed to bring iPods, MP3 players, Gameboys, and other small electronic devices. No laptop computers allowed. These may only be used on the airplane and will be taken to be returned at the end of the trip if used during other parts of the experience.
7. Students should not bring valuables or excessive amounts of money with them.
8. Students on the 10th grade trip are encouraged not to call home; students will benefit and mature from spending a week independent of their parents and families. Students on the 10th grade trips are not permitted to use the hotel room phones to make local or long distance phone calls.
9. Students who are ill prior to leaving on the trip should contact the school and NOT attend the field trip.

If a student is in violation of an AIS policy, the student's parents will be contacted and the student sent home at that parent's expense.
