

Field Trip Rules and Guidelines

- All students are expected to abide by all AIS rules and guidelines as listed in the handbook, including the prohibition of the use of tobacco products, alcohol, and drugs.
- All students are to abide by the rules established by the organization hired by the school to provide the field trip experience.
- Students are to be respectful at all times to AIS staff, other adults designated to work with them, and fellow students.
- Students are expected to arrive to activities promptly and to participate to the fullest of their abilities.
- Students will have a specific chaperone responsible for them and will be required at designated times to check in with them.
- Students should not bring valuables or excessive amounts of money with them.
- Students on the 6th through 8th Grade trips are encouraged NOT to call home; in cases of emergency, parents will be contacted immediately. *Students should not use cell phones during the trip unless given permission by a chaperone.*
- Students who are ill prior to leaving on the trip should contact the school and NOT attend the field trip.

If a student is in flagrant violation of the AIS policy, the student's parents will be contacted and the student sent home at the parent's expense.
